

Rosary Mysteries: Their Fruit and Possible Recurring Phrases After the Name of Jesus

The Joyful Mysteries:

The Annunciation – with the fruit of “humility” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Word made flesh, or beloved son of Mary, the Incarnate One, Emmanuel, who stoops into our littleness. . .

The Visitation – with fruit of “love of neighbor” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the joy giver, or who visits the lowly, the welcomed guest, who rejoices the soul, who gives joy to the unborn. . .

The Nativity – with fruit of “detachment and poverty of spirit” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the joy of the world, or the Infant in the manger, the song of angels, whom shepherds see, whom wiseman seek. . .

The Presentation – with fruit of “obedience” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the glory of Israel, or the delight of the lowly, the promised Messiah, revealer of hearts, God made visible, privilege presence of love

The Finding of Jesus – with fruit of “piety” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, in his Father’s house, or the teacher to the wise, the obedient son, the joy of family life, the hidden pearl of wisdom. . .

The Luminous Mysteries:

The Baptism of Jesus – with fruit of “openness to the Holy Spirit” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the beloved Son, or whom the Father is well pleased, whom the Spirit descends, who makes us beloved children

The Wedding Feast at Cana – with the fruit of “to Jesus through Mary” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the miracle worker, or the gracious listener, his mother’s son, the new wine maker, the water changer . . .

The Proclamation of the Kingdom – with the fruit of “repentance, trust in God,” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, proclaiming the kingdom, or our good news, who sends us out, compassionate king. . .

The Transfiguration – with fruit of “Desire for Holiness” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, our Transfigured Savior, or our Beloved Transformer, the Heaven Sent One, our Holy Desire. . .

The Institution of the Eucharist - with fruit of “Eucharistic Adoration or Active Participation at Mass” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Bread of Life, or our Divine Communion, the True Manna . . .

The Sorrowful Mysteries:

The Agony in the Garden – with fruit of “Contrition, Conformity to the Will of God” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Son of Man in the Garden, or the Obedient Son, Solicitor of Our Prayers. . .

The Scourging at the Pillar – with fruit of “Purity, Mortification” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Scourged One, or By Whose Stripes We Are Healed, Who Splatters His Blood Upon Us. . .

The Crowning with Thorns – with fruit of “Moral Courage” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Crowned with Thorns, or Whose Honor is So Mocked, Robed in Humility, Who Bears Our Insults. . .

The Carrying of the Cross – with the fruit of “Patience” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Who Carries Our Burdens, or Who Walks in Our Dark Valleys, or Who is Patient When We Stumble, the Yoke Bearer. . .

The Crucifixion – with the fruit of “Salvation, Self-Denial” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Who Died for Me, or the Lamb of God, Who Thirsts for Souls, Who Finished the Race, Who Breathed His Last . . .

The Glorious Mysteries:

The Resurrection – with the fruit of “Faith” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Risen One, or Triumphant over Death, or Risen from the Grave, Bursting with Life, Tomb Shaker, Death Deliverer. . .

The Ascension – with the fruit of “Hope, Desire of Heaven” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, the Ascended One, or Our Sure Hope, Our Host in Heaven, Who Went on Before Us, Our True Anchor. . .

The Descent of the Holy Spirit – with the fruit of “Wisdom, Love of God” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Sending the Spirit, or Blessing Bestower, the Gift Giver, the Spirit Baptizer, Fire Descender. . .

The Assumption – with fruit of “Devotion to Mary” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Assuming His Mother, Leading Souls to Heaven, Calling Us Homeward, Who Prepares Our Place in Heaven . . .

The Coronation of Mary – with fruit of “Eternal Happiness” and the recurring phrase about Jesus, Crowning the Queen, or the Crown Giver, the Fulfilment of All Desires, Our Bridegroom Who Awaits. . .
