

Jesus Was Handed Over

All things have been **handed over** to me by my Father; and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son & anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. Lk 10:22

See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be **handed over** to the chief priests and the scribes, and they will condemn him to death; then they will **hand him over** to the Gentiles. Mk 10:33

Judas asked, "What are you willing to give me if I **hand him over** to you?" Mt 26:15

Then they **seized him** and led him away, bringing him into the high priest's house. Lk 22:54

Now the men who were holding Jesus began to mock him and beat him. Lk 22:64

Those who had arrested Jesus **took him to Caiaphas the high priest**, in whose house the scribes and the elders had gathered. Mt 26:57

Then they **spat in his face and struck him**; and some slapped him. Mt 26:67

As soon as it was morning, the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council. They bound Jesus, led him away, and **handed him over to Pilate**. Mk 15:1

Jesus answered him, "You would have no power **over** me unless it had been given you from above; therefore **the one who handed me over to you is guilty** of a greater sin." Jn 19:11

And when he learned that he was under Herod's jurisdiction, he **sent him off to Herod**, who was himself in Jerusalem at that time. Lk 23:7

Even Herod with his soldiers treated him with contempt and mocked him; then he put an elegant robe on him, and **sent him back to Pilate**. Lk 23:11

So Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released Barabbas for them; and after **flogging** Jesus, he **handed him over to be crucified**. Mk 15:5

They spat on him, and took the reed and struck him on the head. After mocking him, they stripped him of the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they **led him away to crucify him**. Mt 27: 30-31

Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be **handed over** to sinners, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again. Lk 24: 6-7

This man, **handed over** to you according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of those outside the law. Ac 2:13
